The History of Rider Education of New Jersey

Rider Education of NJ has been offering the Motorcycle Safety Foundation motorcycle RiderCourses since 1990. RENJ is a non-profit educational organization based in Edison, NJ and is fully approved to teach those courses by the MSF and the state of New Jersey. The RENJ program is considered one of the best run motorcycle safety training and education operations in the country with some of the best trained and motivated RiderCoaches anywhere.

Originally known as Rider Education of Jersey ABATE the program eventually came to be known as RIDER EDUCATION OF NEW JERSEY. Through the efforts of Bill Turkus and many ABATE members the program incorporated and filed for non-profit status. In July of 1990 the first class was held, an Experienced Rider Course at the Middlesex County Vocational and Technical High School in Piscataway.

Rider Education of NJ has grown in leaps and bounds. Although some training sites have come and gone others remain the mainstay of our program. Our instructors continue to teach year after year, and our ever growing number of students continue to ride year after year. Word of mouth, be it our instructors or our students remains our strongest marketing strategy. Many of our students have become RENJ instructors and our instructors are the most experienced in the state. Motorcycle registrations continue to grow while the accident and fatality rates go down.

But we're not done. The RENJ Board of Directors each work their area of expertise and combine as a team to offer the best program possible. Our office staff and instructors, or RiderCoaches as they are now known, work just as hard to insure a quality experience for all. There are monthly meetings and a winter workshop to keep us all at the top of our game. Introductory Motorcycle Experience - IME

The **IME** is a two-hour, first-touch experience with a motorcycle. (Not designed to teach actual riding skills.) Focused on reviewing a motorcycle's primary parts and controls, it helps you determine whether motorcycling is a good personal choice. You are given the option to manipulate the controls while astride a motorcycle. A self-assessment component ensures you are aware of the risks and requirements for being a good, safe and responsible rider. This program is only available at our Lincroft location.

**MVC Written & Road Test Waived*

Basic RiderCourse - BRC

The **BRC** is designed to teach the novice motorcyclist the skills required to ride in a safe manner on the street. The course of instruction takes the beginning rider through the basics of motorcycle operation, straight line riding, turning, shifting, stopping and safe riding strategies. Due to the demanding nature of the course, approximately 15-18 hours are required to administer the program, including your eCourse, with time being allocated for breaks, lunch and weather conditions. Your pre-course assignment (eCourse) will be emailed to you upon registration.

The Basic RiderCourse program provides motorcycles (100cc to 350cc) and instructional material for student use.

If you have a valid NJ driver license, successful completion of the Basic RiderCourse program waives the MVC written and road tests. The student goes to MVC after the course to turn in the paperwork to receive their motorcycle endorsement. If you do not have a valid NJ driver license or you have an out of state license, the written and road test cannot be waived. You may want to check with your insurance company as some insurance companies give discounts for passing the Basic RiderCourse.

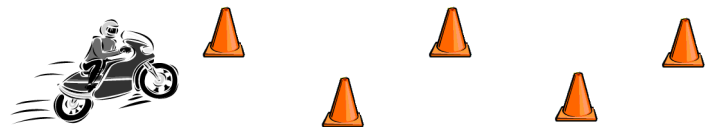

3 Wheel Basic RiderCourse – 3WBRC

The **3WBRC** is the best place for a new rider to start once they have made the decision to ride a 3-wheel motorcycle. This course consists of classroom activities and on-cycle riding exercises. Your pre-course assignment will be emailed to you upon registration. Successful completion may lead to an insurance discount. Students must pass a knowledge and skill test for successful completion. This course qualifies for the NJ road test waiver for a 3 wheel only motorcycle endorsement.

The 3WBRC is offered at our Piscataway, Lincroft & Washington locations. You will use our brand new 3Wheelers for you to use for the whole course.

Additional Practice RiderCourse - APRC

The **APRC** is an extension of the Basic RiderCourse that serves two purposes. For those riders who wish to get in a little more practice before venturing onto the roadways on their own, this class offers an additional day of range exercises on RENJ motorcycles. For students who completed the BRC but were unsuccessful in the Skills Evaluation, this class is your opportunity for a day of practice and to retake the Skills Evaluation. In a nut shell the APRC is a one day class composed of range exercises, additional practice time and coaching, followed up with a skills evaluation. By the end of class each student should be able to measure the progress they have made and re-evaluate their needs as it pertains to becoming a skilled motorcyclist.

Call the RENJ office to see if you are eligible and to schedule yourself for the APRC. The APRC is currently only offered at our Piscataway location.

APRC Tuition: \$125

Returning Rider - RRBRC

The **RRBRC** combines elements of the BRC and BRC2, and includes knowledge and skill tests. It is designed for riders who already possess basic skill but have not ridden for several years. Even if you were a good rider back in the day, traffic patterns have changed and motorcycles have evolved. For example, technology has bestowed better handling, less weight, and more power within each engine displacement category. See our website for current pricing & important course information.



*The Motor Vehicle Commission's (MVC) Motorcycle Safety Education Program, and its providers have agreed that upon successful completion of a Basic RiderCourse, the student becomes eligible for the knowledge and road test waiver from the MVC.

More amazing motorcycle courses offered at RENJ...

Intermediate RiderCourse - BBBRC

The **BBBRC** is an approximately 5 hour riding course designed to help you develop basic riding skills. Exercises focus on a variety of cornering skills and limited-space maneuvers. By the end of the course, you should be able to handle a motorcycle well enough to negotiate normal street and traffic situations. Motorcycles are provided for your use.

BBBRC Tuition: \$99

Basic RiderCourse2 - BRC2 License Waiver / Skills Practice

Available in a combined format to meet riders' needs:
License Waiver – designed for current motorcycle riders who need to earn a validated motorcycle license. Participants must have a New Jersey motorcycle permit. This course is not an alternative to taking the BRC (Basic RiderCourse). Riders must have on-the-road riding experience, have better than basic riding skills, riders must bring their own (registered, insured and mechanically sound) motorcycle. Students unable to ride the first exercise competently may not be eligible for the LW, although they may be allowed to stay and ride to practice their skills. *Participants are required to complete an on-line eCourse before attending the class at our Motorcycle Safety Foundation approved range.* Successful completion of a knowledge test and a skills test is required for a New Jersey MOST waiver.

Skills Practice – The goal of this course is to help you further refine your motorcycle handling skills and grow your confidence in your riding ability. Ideal participants are past BRC, Intermediate, or BRC2 graduates looking to gain additional hands-on experience and practice or renew their riding skills. Successful completion of the knowledge test is required. (skills test is optional) Participants must complete an on-line eCourse before attending.

These courses are state of New Jersey approved as a defensive driving course and, upon passing, entitles you to a two-point reduction from your driver's license, as well as a possible discount on your insurance. Manufacturers or riding groups may offer discounts or benefits for participating in the BRC2. You will be required to do a general inspection of your motorcycle before participating. The Basic RiderCourse 2 License Waiver / Skills Practice is a full day course. Actual time may vary.

BRC2 Tuition: \$125

Advanced RiderCourse - ARC

The **ARC** is a one-day course that complements a rider's basic skills and helps with personal risk assessment. It includes a fast-paced classroom segment with several interactive activities to improve perception and hazard awareness. Range exercises enhance both basic skills and crash avoidance skills. Improving braking skills and cornering finesse is emphasized. The course is beneficial for riders on any type of street motorcycle and is taken on your own motorcycle. Individuals can enroll as well as special group ARCs through the RENJ office. The ARC is not a defensive riding course and does not qualify for a 2 point reduction. Already took the Basic RiderCourse 2? Now come back and take the Advanced RiderCourse!

ARC Tuition: \$150

Ultimate RiderCourse - UBBRC

The **UBBRC** is an approximately 5 hour riding course for very experienced riders. There is no formal classroom and the riding exercises focus on limited-space maneuvers, modeled after police training courses. Through progressively challenging exercises, you develop smooth and precise control and learn more about the limits of your abilities and your own motorcycle's capability. Good bike bonding helps riders automate their physical skills so they can devote more attention to road and traffic conditions (searching and evaluating). This helps a rider to be a better decision maker.

UBBRC Tuition: \$175
